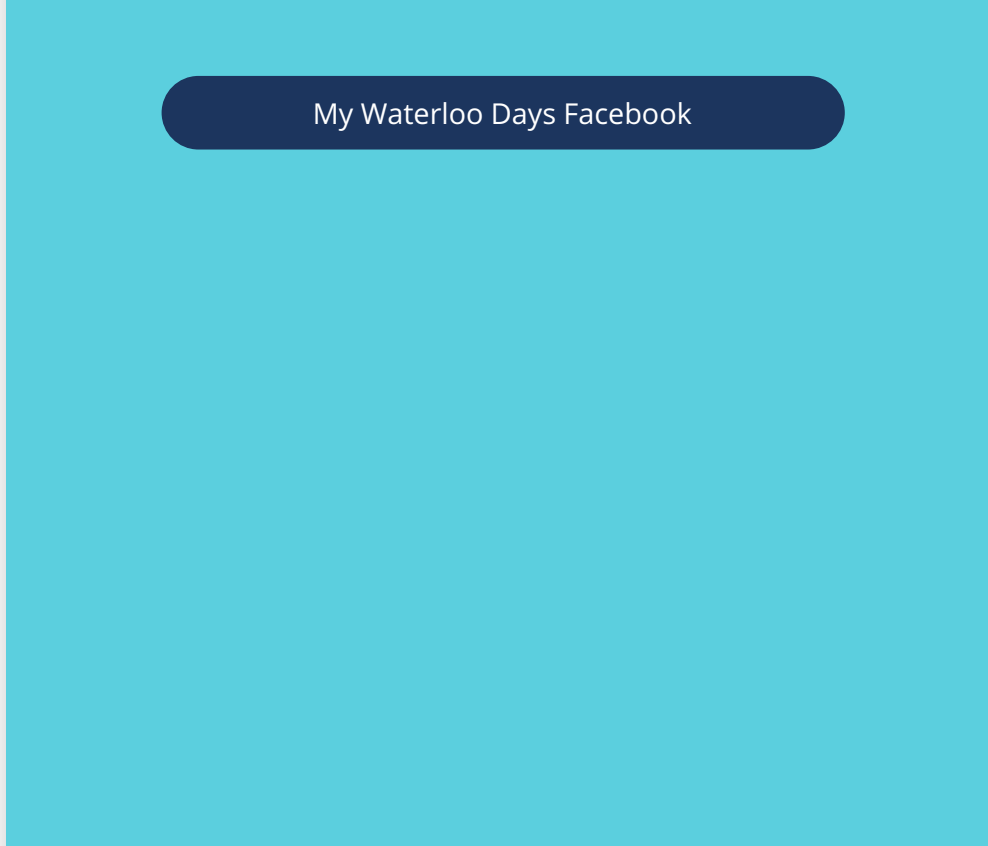

### SAFETY AT THE MARKET

The Waterloo Urban Farmers Market is committed to providing continued access to local food and products while maintaining safe market operations for the 2020 season and beyond. To help us ensure a safe environment for our customers, vendors, and staff during the challenging times of COVID-19 we've adopted the following guidelines:

- Stay home if sick
- Wear a mask while visiting the market
- Protect yourself and others by practicing the 6-foot "social distancing guidelines"
- Shop alone; do not visit the market in groups
- No children or pets
- Do not touch products; allow vendors to assemble your products
- Consider asking a friend or family member to shop for you if needed
- Create a purchase list to expedite your time spent at the market
- Wash your hands using the handwashing stations set up at the market

### BENEFIT PROGRAMS

**DOUBLE UP FOOD BUCKETS**  
Get free fruits and veggies at the market with your SNAP/EBT benefits. Visit the information booth to receive Double Up Food Bucks coupons (up to \$10 per day) to spend on local fruits and vegetables.

**VEGETABLE VOUCHERS**  
Coupons are worth \$3 each that can be spent on fresh produce. You can find more information about qualifying for Vegetable Vouchers at the following locations: Black Home County Health Department, Peoples Community Health Clinic, ManyaOne, and UnityPoint Health.

**FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM**  
Look for signage reading "Farmers Market Nutrition Program Checks Welcome here" as an indication that the vendor is certified to accept FHN's SNAP checks or visit the information booth for a full list of participating vendors.

**WIC AND SENIOR VOUCHERS**  
Use WIC and Senior Vouchers with participating food products at the Waterloo Urban Farmers Market.

### Why a complete count matters:

Getting a complete and accurate count of Black Hawk County's population determines our state's representation in Congress. It also determines the distribution of more than \$675 billion in federal funding for vital programs and services in education, health, housing, public safety, and transportation.

For the first time, the 2020 Census will be available ONLINE. Watch your mail for your envelope with personalized code to enter.

The Census is confidential. It is the Census Bureau's legal duty to protect your information.
